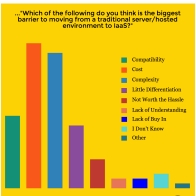


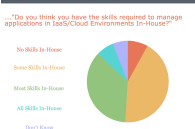
Overall, cost saving and flexibility are the two main motivators when moving towards IaaS.



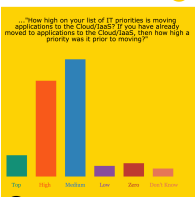
The two biggest barriers stopping people moving to IaaS are cost and complexity.



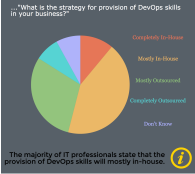
The majority of IT professionals would use a third party to manage a move to IaaS.



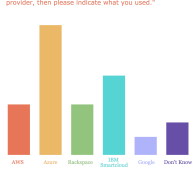
Only 7% believe they have all the skills to manage IaaS/Cloud applications in-house.



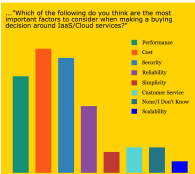
Moving applications to the Cloud/IaaS is high or medium priority for most.



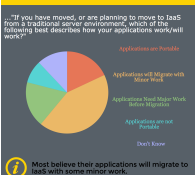
The majority of IT professionals state that the provision of DevOps skills will mostly in-house.



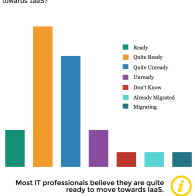
Microsoft Azure is the favoured IaaS provider.
